Epp Lauk, Ph.D. is Professor of Journalism at the Department of Language and Communication Studies at the University of Jyväskylä, Finland. She has worked for the University of Tartu, Estonia, as a researcher, Associate Professor and Professor; as Guest Professor at the University of Oslo, Norway and at the University of Umeå, Sweden, as Bonnier Professor at the University of Stockholm and as Visiting Professor at Vytautas Magnus University of Kaunas, Lithuania. In 2011-2012 she worked six months as Visiting Fellow of the Media and Democracy in Central and Eastern Europe project at Oxford University. During her nearly four decades of academic experience, Professor Lauk has supervised numerous M.A. theses and PhD dissertations and taught a number of classes on all levels of University education. She has led and participated in numerous nationally and internationally funded media and journalism research projects. Lauk's publications include over 150 articles
